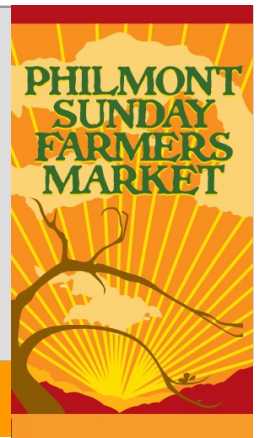

1. Contestant(s) should fill out this form and bring it with them to the market to enter the Apple Pie Cook Off.
2. Delivery of your entry pie to arrive at the Philmont Farmers' Market by 11am to enter the cook off. Late comers will not be eligible to enter.
3. Contestants must be 18 years of age or older, or if younger than 18 years of age must have a pie making partner who is 18 years of age or older identified on this entry form.
4. Each pie must have the ingredients clearly written on a label.
 - a) must be a home made baked pie (no store purchase),
 - b) must have at least 50% of the ingredients purchased in New York State,
 - c) must list the name of the farm, farmstand, and/or store the main ingredients (i.e. apples) were purchased or sourced from,
 - d) pie must be individually wrapped with food protective plastic wrap or in a cardboard cake box.
